#### **Include Account Holder Name**

Students can use Family and/or Friend Funding! NU Loans are accepted. If the funding source is not in student's name, please include the completed and signed <u>Sponsor Statement of Support Form</u> (name, address, relation, amount, signature, and date).

# Include Currency Type, Account Type, & Dated in the Last Six Months

These details must be clearly included/noted on **ALL** financial documents.

### **Must be translated into English**

If the financial institution does not provide translated documents, students may complete their own translations for the I-20/DS-2019 Request. Students **MUST** obtain a certified translation **BEFORE** their F-1/J-1 visa appointment.

#### Liquid funds are best!

Examples of funds include checking, savings, term deposits. We do accept investment accounts but do not always recommend these type of accounts as they are not as liquid.

#### **ONLY** the account balance is needed.

We do NOT need the transaction history.

#### **Other Important Reminders:**

- Watch the financial documentation video.
- Review the <u>financial documentation website</u> before submitting your I-20/DS-2019 Request.
- Admissions Deposit is not an accepted financial document.

Any issues with your financial documents will result in a delay in the issuance of your I-20/DS-2019
